	of birth and address. To confirm eligibility, details of the disability or disabilities is also required.
	The data is stored securely by EitC in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation. Applicants
	have a right to access and correct the information held; it can also be deleted at any time; although this may
	affect your membership.
